【問題】 次の文を読み、続く設問に答えなさい。

Being fair goes along with sincerity and concern. Everyone wants a fair chance to show what he or she can do. They want the opportunity! Each day the coach has to evaluate personnel. Each team member must be reviewed and analyzed. 1) Great coaches have the gift of being able to evaluate personnel quickly and get them into the proper position and proper pecking order. But even great coaches can be 4) fooled. A player can come out of nowhere to make a great contribution to the team. An attribute of many excellent coaches is that they spend as much time as possible with the second stringers and make them feel valuable to the team. Many teams win championships because the second team constantly pushed the first team to greater heights.

5) Never discuss one of your player's abilities with another player on the team, because jealousies can occur over the slightest situation. Instead, you should make positive comments during and after practice and games. 2) It is always easier to compliment the team rather than a few individuals.

In the area of being fair and making evaluations, beware of parental familiarity. Try to distance yourself from the parents of the youngsters you are coaching. 3) It is difficult to maintain objectivity if you are friends with the parents. This is especially difficult when you are coaching in a small community.

For reasons like these, coaching can become a lonely profession. Let's hope that your players will sense the difficulty of your decisions and apply that fairness to their life decisions.
